



Scholarships at CFGCR

- Scholarships are awarded from 95 separate funds.
 - Of the 95 funds, 17 of those funds are not designated as official scholarship funds due to a lack of fund value or for flexibility.
 - Many of these funds award multiple scholarships including the Phyllis E. Dake Make Your Own Scholarship Fund, Austin & Co., Inc. Scholarship Fund, AngioDynamics We BELIEVE in Education Scholarship
 - There are also multi-year scholarships that include Herbert K. Liebich Two-Year and Four-Year Scholarships, John A. Boyd Scholarship (Two-Year and Four-Year) , Tina A. Dailey Memorial Scholarship, William Randolph Hearst Endowed Scholarship (awarded to graduating 8th grader who has been accepted and plans to attend a private high school)
- In 2025, the Community Foundation awarded **\$693,000 in scholarships to 234 students.**
- Our staff work with several people to select students. This includes the individual fund scholarship committees for those who choose to be very active in selecting the scholarship recipient as well as the CFGCR Scholarship Committee chaired by board member Eldon Harris and includes board member Crickett Thomas-O'Dell, staff members Terry Mariano and Arianna Bullock , and UAlbany professor Heta-Maria Miller
- All scholarships are endowed, permanent funds
- The minimum to establish a scholarship fund is \$30,000
