- 1. The name of the proposed corporation is:

 COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF ALBANY, NEW YORK, INC.
- 2. The purposes for which the corporation is to be formed are as follows:
 - A. To use, apply and devote its properties and funds exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes, through the making of grants or otherwise extending financial assistance and support to duly authorized persons.
 - B. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Instrument, the Foundation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on:
 - (1) By an organization exempt from Pederal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision then in effect of any future United States Internal Revenue law), or
 - (2) By an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision then in effect of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

- c. For the purpose of accomplishing the foregoing objectives, to acquire, take, have and hold by gift, grant, bequest, devise or otherwise, any and all property, real or personal, and any and all interests therein; and without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to receive the income or principal to this corporation to be used by it for any of the said purposes, and to apply and distribute the money, securities or other property thus received for any of said purposes as the same shall have been designated by the grantors or donors thereof, or if no purpose or purposes shall have been designated by the grantors or donors thereof, or if such designation shall be impractical, or impossible of fulfillment, to the accomplishment of such of the foregoing objectives as the directors of the corporation shall determine.
- D. To manage, invest, and reinvest its property, to administer, sell, mortgage, lease, exchange and transfer its property,
 to collect the income therefrom, and generally to deal with and
 expend the corporation's income and principal, all in such manner
 as in the judgment of the directors of the corporation will best
 promote the accomplishment of its objectives.
- E. To enter into, perform and carry out contracts of every kind with any person, firm, association or corporation, and in general to do any and all acts necessary or expedient for the accomplishment of the objectives of the corporation.
- F. Nothing herein contained shall authorize this corporation to undertake or to carry on any of the activities mentioned in Section 11 of the Membership Corporations Law or Section 35 of the Social Services Law of the State of New York.

- In no event shall any portion of the corporate properties or funds, the principal thereof or the income therefrom, inure to the benefit of or ever be distributed to any director, officer or member of the corporation but, as aforesaid, the same shall be exclusively devoted to the accomplishment of the charitable, scientific and educational purposes hereinabove specified.
- 4. Upon dissolution of the corporation any assets of the corporation remaining will be distributed to an organization which has qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision then in effect of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- 5. The territory in which its operations are principally to be conducted is the State of New York within one hundred fifty miles of the center of the City of Albany, New York.
- 6. The principal office to be located in the City of Albany, and the Mark Twater Albany County, in the State of New York.
- 7. The number of the corporation's directors shall be not more than twenty-five nor less than fifteen.


