



### Fee for Service Grantmaking

Area Foundations have come to rely on our grantmaking expertise along with our knowledge of local non-profit organizations. We currently work with five local foundations to assist them in their grantmaking efforts. The foundations pay us a fee for service equivalent to 5% of their annual grantmaking.

#### **Bender Family Foundation**

The Bender Family Foundation works to foster, preserve and fund the arts, culture, education, history and environment of New York State's Capital Region.

#### **McCarthy Charities**

Founded in 1917, The McCarthy Charities, Inc. is a family foundation focused on improving the quality of life in Rensselaer County, especially in the areas of education, social services and housing.

#### **B'nai B'rith Gideon Foundation**

The B'nai B'rith Gideon Foundation was established to support rental housing and/or related social and recreational facilities for low-income elderly individuals, persons with disabilities and families of low-income residents living in New York State's Capital Region.

Our grantmaking will focus on organizations working in the areas of health, education, social services and the arts and should have a significant impact on the quality of life in those geographic areas.
