Endowed for Healthy Communities

The Hortense & Louis Rubin Community Health Fund

Established in 2016, the Rubin Community Health Fund was created with the initial proceeds from the operation and sale of the Rubin Dialysis Centers. Annual contributions expanded the endowed fund until the final distribution in 2021.

The Fund honors Louis and Hortense Rubin, who spent their lives supporting organizations that improved the quality of life across our community. Today, their enduring passion and commitment continue to guide and inspire the Fund's impactful grantmaking.

The Alice P. Kenney Endowed Fund

Established earlier this year, Marjorie Kenney's estate was designated to create the Alice P. Kenney Fund in memory of her daughter Alice, who exemplified courage, scholarship, and generosity throughout the Capital Region.

Grants from the Fund will provide meaningful support to a diverse group of nonprofit organizations working to address critical community needs and strengthen services for children and families.

The Fund was created to provide annual support to 10 public charities that Marjorie cared for during her lifetime, and the remaining spendable distribution each year is earmarked for the greatest needs facing children across the Capital Region.

Endowed for Special Places

The Ann Swyer Ten Broeck Mansion Endowment Fund

Established in 2011 with gifts from Ann Swyer and her family to preserve and forever care for the needs of the organization she loved.

Each year, Ten Broeck Mansion receives an unrestricted grant from Ann's fund.
